Discussion Guide for Zoom Groups

Q: What stood out to you?

Q: What historically have you been taught or believe about miraculous healing?

Q: Molly mentioned that Peter and John had likely seen this man several times before. What changed?

Q: What can keep us from praying for miraculous healing?

Read James 5:13-16:

Is anyone among you in trouble? Let them pray. Is anyone happy? Let them sing songs of praise. Is anyone among you sick? Let them call the elders of the church to pray over them and anoint them with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise them up. If they have sinned, they will be forgiven. Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective.

Q: What things does James identify regarding healing? What key points does he make?

Q: What is one way we can practically apply this message in our lives today?

Pray for one another: Take some time to apply this message in your group. Identify some needs, either in the group or with people you know, and pray for God’s healing. Be sure to also pray for God to heal people around the world and to heal our land.
