## **Discussion Guide for Zoom Groups**

Q: What stood out to you?

Q: What do you think about the idea that God doesn't need our help, but chooses to collaborate with us? Agree? Disagree? Why?

Q: What is the practical outcome of this belief?

## Read 2 Peter 3:8-9

But do not forget this one thing, dear friends: With the Lord a day is like a thousand years, and a thousand years are like a day. The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. Instead he is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.

## Read 1 Timothy 2:3-6

This is good, and pleases God our Savior, who wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth. For there is one God and one mediator between God and mankind, the man Christ Jesus, who gave himself as a ransom for all people. This has now been witnessed to at the proper time.

Q: In theory, I think we'd all agree that we believe that God wants everyone to know Him and be saved. But in practice, do we find ourselves not fully believing that? Are there people we think, "that person would never accept Jesus." In an honoring way, share some examples.

Q: Are there demographics of people that you find yourself (even subconsciously) dismissing in this regard?



Q: What is one way you can practically apply this message in your life today?

<u>Pray for People You Know Who Don't Know Jesus:</u> Take some time to prayer together for people in your lives who don't know Jesus. Pray the Holy Spirit would work in them and would use you as part of His plan. Pray that the Lord would help you to hear His voice for how you can help and that you would have the boldness to respond.
